- Exercises creativity in supporting people with disabilities to pursue a full range of career opportunities
- Provides effective direct supports necessary to help people with disabilities succeed in the workplace
- Delivers responsive consultation services to employers interested in diversifying their workforce through inclusion of people with disabilities
